# Large Animals Market (1 Head)

- Market Hogs
  - In this project, you raise a market hog for 4-5 months to showcase at our fair with the option to sell through the auction, possibly selling for \$800-1200
- Market Goat
  - In this project, you raise a market goat for 4-5 months to showcase at our fair with the option to sell through auction, possibly for \$1000
- Market Lamb
  - In this project, you raise a market lamb for 4-5 months to showcase at our fair with the option to sell through auction, possibly for \$1000
- Market Beef
  - In this project, you raise a market beef for 8-9 months to showcase at our fair with the option to sell through auction, possibly \$4000-6000



# Small Animals

- Rabbits
  - Market Rabbits
  - In this project you raise 3 market rabbits and sell them at fair for \$25
  - Show rabbits
  - In this project, you pick and choose a rabbit and to the best of your abilities you show it at fair.
- Poultry
  - Pen of 3 Laying Hens
  - In this project you show 3 of your laying hens, and you can show them at the fair.
  - 1 Meat Pen (3 Meat Chickens)
  - In this project, students are able to pick and raise 3 meat birds for the fair. You raise them for 1 month. If your pen makes grand or reserve champion, you can sell your birds in the auction for \$250-\$500.
